

RESOLUTION NO. 83-21

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST ADOPTING IN PRINCIPLE THAT A SITE LOCATED ON CITY OWNED PROPERTY NEAR THE GOLF CENTER OR THE OLD CITY SEWER PLANT BE SELECTED AS A LOCATION FOR A NEW ANIMAL SHELTER.

WHEREAS, the City of Ridgecrest is in need of a new animal shelter facility; and

WHEREAS, The Ridgecrest City Council has appointed a Citizen Committee to recommend an appropriate site for locating a new animal shelter facility; and

WHEREAS, The Citizen Committee has recommended strongly that a preferred location for a new animal control facility would be to utilize City owned property near the City Golf Center or near the old City Sewer Treatment Plant.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Ridgecrest City Council that it in principle designates City owned property near the Golf Center or near the old Sewer Treatment Plant as the preferred location for a new animal shelter facility; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that City staff be directed to develop cost estimates for site preparation for at least three specific locations on the City owned property designated as follows:

1. Immediately North of the Golf Center parking lot.
2. South of the Golf Center driving range.
3. Immediately North of the old Sewer Treatment Plant.
