

RESOLUTION NO. 83-25

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST REMOVING THE REQUIREMENT FOR RECREATIONAL VEHICLE PARKING IN UNITS P AND T OF TRACT 4244 (WHERRY HOUSING - PLANNED UNIT DEVELOPMENT/CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT 79-13).

WHEREAS, China Lake Investments has requested that the provisions for recreational vehicle parking be deleted from the conditions of approval for the Planned Unit Development/Conditional Use Permit 79-13; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Ridgecrest did consider said request at the regular meeting on May 16, 1983, at which time the pros and cons of the requirement for an RV parking area were freely discussed; and

WHEREAS, the recreational vehicle parking area, because of its lack of use by the residents of Cimarron Gardens, presents an opportunity to use the land more cost effectively; and

WHEREAS, it is the decision of the City Council of the City of Ridgecrest to delete the requirements for a recreational vehicle parking area in the Cimarron Gardens portion of the Wherry Housing;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST RESOLVES:

That the City Council of the City of Ridgecrest approves the deletion of the requirement for a recreational vehicle parking area from Units P and T of Tract 4244.
