

RESOLUTION NO. 83-28

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST, CALIFORNIA, AUTHORIZING SUBMITTAL OF APPLICATION FOR TDA FUNDS FOR FISCAL YEAR 1983-84

WHEREAS, the Transportation Development Act as amended provides for the disbursement of funds from the Local Transportation Fund held in trust by the Kern County Auditor-Controller for use by eligible claimants for the purpose authorized by Article 8, Section 99400(a) and 99405(b) Streets and Roads and Article 4, Section 99260(a) Public Transportation; and

WHEREAS, an eligible claimant wishing to receive an allocation from the Local Transportation Fund must file its application with the Kern County Council of Governments pursuant to the rules and regulations that have been adopted by the Secretary of the Business and Transportation Agency of the State of California in accordance with the provisions of the aforementioned legislation; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Ridgecrest has duly considered and received testimony on the subject of transit needs within its jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, funds from the Local Transportation Fund will be required to maintain the street and road system and construct new streets;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

1. There are at this time no unmet transit needs which could reasonably be met; and
2. That the Finance Officer is authorized to execute and file an appropriate claim pursuant to the terms of the Transportation Development Act of 1982, as amended, and pursuant to application rules and regulations promulgated thereunder, together with all necessary supporting documents, with the Kern County Council of Governments for fiscal year 1983-84 Transportation Development Act monies; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a copy of this resolution be transmitted to the Kern County Council of Governments in conjunction with the filing of claims; and the Kern County Council of Governments be requested to concur in these findings and grant the allocations of funds as specified on the Article 8 claim.

WHEREAS, funds from the Local Transportation Fund will be required to maintain the street and road system and construct new streets;


NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALBUQUERQUE RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:
