

2. The State will prepare PS&E, advertise, award and administer this project.
3. The State will provide a Resident Engineer to administer this contract.
4. The City of Ridgecrest will reimburse the State for their share of costs for work requested to be performed by the State.
5. In agreeing to the award of contract, the Local Agency agrees that payment of Federal funds will be limited to the Detail Estimate amount approved by the Federal Highway Administration in the Federal-Aid Project Agreement (PR-2), or its modification (PR-2A), and accepts any increases in Local Agency funds.
6. The use of Federal funds for this project is subject to the project being selected as part of the County FAU Program for the Ridgecrest Urban Area.
7. The availability of Federal funds will be subject to meeting deadlines and/or other conditions as may be imposed by the Director upon the recommendation of the Federal-Aid Urban Advisory Committee.
8. In executing this Program Supplement, the Local Agency hereby reaffirms the "Nondiscrimination Assurances" for Federal-Aid Programs contained in the aforementioned Master Agreement.
