

RESOLUTION NO. 83- 48

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST APPROVING THE NEGATIVE DECLARATION FOR THE 1983 IMPROVEMENT PROJECT - ASSESSMENT DISTRICT NO. 14, HAVING FOUND THAT THE PROJECT WILL NOT HAVE A SUBSTANTIAL ADVERSE IMPACT ON THE ENVIRONMENT.

WHEREAS, the City of Ridgecrest has evaluated the economic and physical environmental impacts for Assessment District No. 14; and

WHEREAS, the Engineer's Report has been prepared for Assessment District No. 14; and

WHEREAS, the majority of land owners within the boundary of said improvement district have signed petitions expressing their desire to form said district; and

WHEREAS, the formation of the district and the improvements will contribute to the economic growth of the city; and

WHEREAS, the Initial Study prepared by the City did not disclose any adverse environmental effects that could not be mitigated:

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST HEREBY RESOLVES:




