

RESOLUTION NO. 83-66

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST, CALIFORNIA, REQUESTING THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF KERN TO: (1) CONSOLIDATE A SPECIAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION OR (2) TO RENDER SPECIFIED SERVICES TO THE CITY RELATING TO THE CONDUCT OF A SPECIAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE HELD IN THE CITY ON TUESDAY, DECEMBER 13, 1983.

WHEREAS, a Special Municipal Election is to be held in the City of Ridgecrest, California, on Tuesday, December 13, 1983;

WHEREAS, a statewide special election was called to be held on the same day but has been challenged in the California Supreme Court and may not be held;

WHEREAS, if the statewide election is held, the City wishes to consolidate its Special election with the statewide election, but if the statewide election is not held, the City wishes to request special services from the County of Kern in order to conduct its own election; and

WHEREAS, all necessary expense in performing this service or consolidation shall be paid by the City of Ridgecrest;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST, CALIFORNIA, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE, DECLARE, DETERMINE AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. If the Statewide Special Election is held on December 13, 1983, Sections 3 and 4 will be effective and Section 5 will be void.

SECTION 2. If the Statewide Special election is not held on December 13, 1983, Section 5 will be effective and Sections 3 and 4 will be void.

SECTION 3. That pursuant to the requirements of Section 23302 of the Elections Code, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Kern is requested to allow the consolidation of a special municipal election with the statewide special election on Tuesday, December 13, 1983, for the purpose of submitting to the electors of the City of Ridgecrest a measure to appear on the ballot as follows:

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, REQUESTING THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF KERN TO: (1) CONSTITUTE A SPECIAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION (2) TO RENDER SPECIAL SERVICES TO THE CITY RELATING TO THE CONDUCT OF A SPECIAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE HELD IN THE CITY ON TUESDAY, DECEMBER 13, 1988.

WHEREAS, a special municipal election is to be held in the City of Riverside, California, on Tuesday, December 13, 1988;

AND WHEREAS, a statewide special election was called to be held on the same day and has been challenged in the California Supreme Court and may not be held;

AND WHEREAS, if the statewide election is held, the City wishes to conduct a special election with the statewide election, but if the statewide election is not held, the City wishes to request special services from the County of Kern in order to conduct the election; and

AND WHEREAS, all necessary expenses in performing this service on behalf of the City of Riverside shall be paid by the City of Riverside;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE, DECLARE, DETERMINE AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. If the statewide special election is held on December 13, 1988, sections 2 and 4 will be effective and section 3 will be void.

SECTION 2. If the statewide special election is not held on December 13, 1988, section 2 will be effective and sections 3 and 4 will be void.

SECTION 3. That pursuant to the provisions of section 21308 of the Elections Code, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Kern is requested to allow the constitution of a special municipal election with the statewide special election on Tuesday, December 13, 1988, for the purpose of submitting to the voters of the City of Riverside a measure to appear on the ballot as follows:

SECTION 4. The County Clerk is hereby authorized to canvass the returns of the special municipal election which is hereby requested to be consolidated with the statewide special election and the election shall be held in all respects as if there were only one election, and only one form of ballot shall be used.

SECTION 5. That pursuant to the provisions of Section 22003 of the Elections Code of the State of California, this City Council hereby requests the Board of Supervisors of the County to permit the County Clerk to prepare and furnish to the City for use in conducting the election, computer labels with the names and addresses of all eligible registered voters in the City and polling place location in order that the City may have labels attached to self-mailer sample ballot pamphlets; and will also furnish to the City printed indicies of the voters to be used by the precinct board at the polling place; and will make available to the City additional election equipment and assistance according to state law.

SECTION 6. That the City shall reimburse the County for services performed when the work is completed and upon presentation to the City of a properly approved bill.

SECTION 7. That the City Clerk is hereby directed to forward without delay to the Board of Supervisors and to the County Clerk, each a certified copy of this Resolution.

SECTION 4. The County Clerk is hereby authorized to prepare the returns of the special election which is hereby scheduled to be conducted on the date of the special election and the election shall be held in all precincts as if there were only one election, and only one form of ballot shall be used.

SECTION 5. That in order to the provisions of Section 2503 of the Election Code of the State of California, this City Clerk hereby requests the Board of Supervisors of the County to order the County Clerk to prepare and furnish to the City for use in conducting the election, counters, labels with the names and addresses of all eligible registered voters in the City and certain other locations in order that the City may have labels attached to self-mailing sample ballot envelopes and that the City printed notices of the voters to be used by the Board at the polling places and all other available to the City. Additional election equipment and assistance according to state law.

SECTION 6. That the City shall reimburse the County for services performed when the work is completed and upon presentation to the City of a properly approved bill.

SECTION 7. That the City Clerk is hereby directed to forward without delay to the Board of Supervisors and to the County Clerk, each a certified copy of this Resolution.
