

RESOLUTION NO. 83-82

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST, CALIFORNIA, ESTABLISHING VOTING PRECINCTS AND POLLING PLACES, APPOINTING PRECINCT BOARD MEMBERS AND FIXING COMPENSATION FOR THE SPECIAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION OF SAID CITY ON TUESDAY, DECEMBER 13, 1983, HERETOFORE CALLED BY RESOLUTION NO. 83-65 OF THE CITY COUNCIL

WHEREAS, a Special Municipal Election to be held on Tuesday, December 13, 1983, has been heretofore called by Resolution No. 83-65, adopted on September 6, 1983;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Ridgecrest, California, does hereby resolve, declare, determine and order as follows:

SECTION 1. That the polling places for the respective precincts shall be the places hereinafter designated; and that the persons hereinafter named, being competent and qualified electors and residents of said City are hereby appointed precinct board members of their respective voting precincts and they shall hold said election and make return thereof in the manner provided by law.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND, CALIFORNIA, ESTABLISHING VOTING PRECINCTS AND POLLING PLACES, APPOINTING PRECINCT BOARD MEMBERS AND FIXING COMPENSATION FOR THE SPECIAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION OF SAID CITY ON TUESDAY, DECEMBER 13, 1983, HERETOFORE CALLED BY RESOLUTION NO. 83-82 OF THE CITY COUNCIL

WHEREAS, a Special Municipal Election to be held on Tuesday, December 13, 1983, has been heretofore called by Resolution No. 83-82, adopted on September 27, 1983;

That the City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this Resolution; shall enter the same in the book of original Resolutions of said City; and shall make a minute of passage and adoption thereof in the records of the proceedings of the City Council of said City, in the minutes of the meeting at which time the same is passed and adopted.


