

RESOLUTION NO. 84-25

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST CALIFORNIA, RECITING THE FACT OF THE GENERAL MUNICIPAL AND SPECIAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION HELD IN SAID CITY ON APRIL 10, 1984, DECLARING THE RESULT THEREOF AND SUCH OTHER MATTERS AS ARE PROVIDED BY LAW.

WHEREAS, a General Municipal and Special Municipal Election was held and conducted in the City of Ridgecrest, County of Kern, State of California, on Tuesday, April 10, 1984, as required by law; and

WHEREAS, notice of said election was duly and regularly given in time, form and manner as provided by law; that voting precincts were properly established; that election officers were appointed and that the votes cast thereat, received and canvassed and the returns made and declared in time, form and manner as required by the provisions of the Elections Code of the State of California for the holding of elections in General Law cities; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 83-104 adopted on December 20, 1983, the City Clerk of said City canvassed the returns of said election and has certified the results in this City Council, said results are received, attached and made a part hereof as "Exhibit A."

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST, CALIFORNIA, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE, DECLARE, DETERMINE AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That there were 10 voting precincts established for the purpose of holding said election consisting (of consolidations) of the regular election precincts in said City as established for the holding of state and county elections.

SECTION 2. That said General Municipal and Special Municipal Election was held for the purpose of electing the following officers of said City as required by laws relating to cities in the State of California; to wit:

3 Members of the City Council of said City for the full term of four years;

2 Members of the City Council of said City for the short term of two years;

SECTION 3. That the whole number of votes cast in said City (except absent voter ballots) was 14,555.

That the whole number of absent voter ballots cast in said City was 166, making a total of 15,280 votes cast in said City.

SECTION 4. That the names of persons voted for at said election for Member of the City Council of said City for a full four year term are as follows:

That the number of votes given at each precinct and the number of votes given in the City to each of such persons above named for the respective offices for which said persons were candidates were as listed in Exhibit "A" attached.

SECTION 5. The City Council does declare and determine that:

Michael R. Mower was elected as Member of the City Council of said City for the full term of four years;

Thomas R. Wiknich was elected as Member of the City Council of said City for the full term of four years;

James M. "Jim" Pearson was elected as Member of the City Council of said City for the full term of four years;

Anna Marie Bergens was ^{re} elected as Member of the City Council of said City for the short term of two years;

Florence S. "Flo" Condos was elected as Member of the City Council of said City for the short term of two years;

SECTION 6. The City Clerk shall enter on the records of the City Council of said City, a statement of the result of said election showing:

- (1) The whole number of votes cast in the City - 15,280;
- (2) The names of the persons voted for;
- (3) For what office each person was voted for;
- (4) The number of votes given at each precinct to each person, and for and against each measure;

SECTION 7. That the City Clerk shall immediately make and deliver to of such persons so elected a Certificate of Election signed by the City Clerk and duly authenticated; that the City Clerk shall also administer to each person elected, the Oath of Office prescribed in the State Constitution of the State of California and shall have them subscribe thereto and file the same in the office of the City Clerk. Whereupon, each and all of said persons so elected shall be inducted into the respective office to which they have been elected.

SECTION 8. That the City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this Resolution; shall enter the same in the book of original Resolutions of said City; and shall make a minute of the passage and adoption thereof in the records of the proceedings of the City Council of said City in the minutes of the meeting at which the same is passed and adopted.


