

RESOLUTION NO. 84-32

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST, CALIFORNIA, ACCEPTING A GIFT OF A TRAILER FOR A PORTABLE EMERGENCY OPERATIONS CENTER AND DESIGNATING RACES AS CUSTODIAN.

WHEREAS, in the process of emergency planning for the City of Ridgecrest, a need was found for a portable emergency operating center to be used by the Radio Amateur Civil Emergency Service (RACES); and

WHEREAS, Dr. Joe Mallory has donated a 13 ft. Mercury trailer to be modified into a communications trailer; and

WHEREAS, RACES has offered to modify the trailer, provide radio equipment and qualified operators for use during an emergency without cost to the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST that the City Council accepts the donation of the trailer to the City to be modified as a portable emergency operating center; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council does hereby designate the Radio Amateur Civil Emergency Service of Ridgecrest as custodians of the trailer for maintenance, modification, and upkeep.


