

RESOLUTION NO. 84-61

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST DENYING GENERAL PLAN AMENDMENT 84-02, SEGMENT II, A PROPOSAL TO CHANGE THE EXISTING GENERAL PLAN DESIGNATION OF LOW-DENSITY RESIDENTIAL TO COMMERCIAL/PROFESSIONAL OFFICE ON A TOTAL OF 20 ACRES, GENERALLY LOCATED AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF GATEWAY BLVD. AND UPJOHN AVENUE; RICK STOKES, APPLICANT.

WHEREAS, Rick Stokes has requested a General Plan Amendment; and

WHEREAS, on December 4, 1984, the City Council held a public hearing thereon, notice of time and place having been given as provided by law; and the Planning Commission held a public hearing on November 13, 1984, notice of time and place having been given as provided by law; and

WHEREAS, the staff recommended the application be denied; and

WHEREAS, this Council has considered all the plans, comments, testimony and evidence offered at the time of public hearing and having found General Plan Amendment 84-02, Segment II not to be in the best interest of the public:


NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST RESOLVES:
