

RESOLUTION NO. 84-09

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY
OF RIDGECREST CALIFORNIA, CONCURRING IN
AMENDMENT #1 TO THE KERN COUNTY SOLID WASTE
MANAGEMENT PLAN-1983 REVISION

WHEREAS, the Nejedly-Z'berg Dills Solid Waste Management and Resource Recovery Act of 1978 (hereinafter referred to as the Act) required each county in cooperation with affected local jurisdictions, to prepare a comprehensive, coordinated solid waste management plan; and

WHEREAS, the County of Kern has prepared the Kern County Solid Waste Management Plan-1983 Revision, (hereinafter referred to as CoSWMP); and

WHEREAS, the Act required that an amendment to the CoSWMP shall be subject to the approval by a majority of the cities within the county which contain a majority of the population of the incorporated area of the county; and

WHEREAS, the County of Kern has prepared a proposed Amendment #1 to the CoSWMP; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Department of the County of Kern has prepared a Negative Declaration in relation to the proposed amendment, a copy of which is on file with the County Clerk; and

WHEREAS, this council has held a public hearing regarding the proposed amendment to the CoSWMP; and

WHEREAS, this Council has published in a newspaper of general circulation in the affected jurisdiction at least seven days in advance of the said public hearing;



- a. The objectives set forth in the amendment.
- b. The method and/or organization for implementation of the program.
- c. The procedures for financing the recommended program.
- d. The role identified in the amendment for the City.


