

RESOLUTION NO. 85-25

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST APPROVING THE NEGATIVE DECLARATION FOR THE 1985 STREET IMPROVEMENT PROJECT 16A AND 16B - ASSESSMENT DISTRICT NO. 16, HAVING FOUND THAT THE PROJECT WILL NOT HAVE A SUBSTANTIAL ADVERSE IMPACT ON THE ENVIRONMENT.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Ridgecrest, California, has evaluated the economic and physical environmental impacts for Assessment District No. 16; and

WHEREAS, the Engineer's Report has been prepared for Assessment District No. 16; and

WHEREAS, the majority of land owners within the boundary of said improvement district have signed petitions expressing their desire to form said district; and

WHEREAS, the formation of the district and the improvements will contribute to the economic growth of the city; and


WHEREAS, the Initial Study prepared by the City did not disclose any adverse environmental effects that could not be mitigated:

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST HEREBY RESOLVES:

That the Negative Declaration of Assessment District No. 16 is approved, having found that the project will not have an adverse effect upon the environment and that the Negative Declaration has been prepared in substantial compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act.


