

RESOLUTION NO. 85-26

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY
OF RIDGECREST OVERRULING PROTESTS ON
RESOLUTION NO. 85-13 FOR STREET IMPROVEMENT
PROJECT NO. 16A AND 16B.

WHEREAS, The City Council of the City of Ridgecrest, California, did on May 1, 1985, adopt its Resolution of Intention No. 85-13 to acquire and construct public improvements in and for said City;

WHEREAS, on May 1, 1985, this Council adopted Resolution No. 85-16, appointing time and place of hearing protests in relation to the proposed acquisitions and improvements and directing notice;

WHEREAS, notice was given of the time and place therein stated in the manner provided by law, as appears from the affidavits on file in the office of the City Clerk;

WHEREAS, all written protests and other written communications were publicly read at said meeting and all persons desiring to be heard were fully heard;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST THAT IT IS ORDERED, as follows:

1. That protests against said acquisitions and improvements were not signed by the owners of a majority or more of the area of the lands within the assessment district assessed for the costs and expenses of said work.
2. That said protests be, and each of them are hereby, overruled.
