

RESOLUTION NO. 85-33

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST REQUESTING THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO PROCEED WITH RESCINDING THE FREEWAY ROUTE ADOPTION OF ROUTE 178 ALONG BOWMAN ROAD.

WHEREAS, the State of California Department of Transportation has determined that the Freeway Route designation of Route 178 from the junction of Route 14 to the San Bernardino County Line is no longer necessary, and

WHEREAS, the Department of Transportation has and is undertaking construction projects to widen and improve existing Highway 178 from Route 395 at Inyokern to China Lake Boulevard which will provide the capacity to handle existing and projected traffic volume, and

WHEREAS, the City of Ridgecrest desires to proceed with urgently needed drainage facilities along the existing Bowman Road alignment, and

WHEREAS, rescision of the freeway designation would allow the City of Ridgecrest to better plan for the development of properties adjacent to Bowman Road, and

WHEREAS, rescision of the freeway designation would provide the City with the opportunity to construct a City street along this alignment to serve abutting properties.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Ridgecrest City Council does hereby request that the State of California Department of Transportation proceed with rescinding the freeway route designation of Route 178 from the junction of State Route 14 to the San Bernardino County Line.


