

RESOLUTION NO. 85-53

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST, CALIFORNIA, SUPPORTING THE ANTELOPE VALLEY AS THE LOCATION FOR THE SUPERCONDUCTING SUPER COLLIDER.

WHEREAS, the California Site Selection Committee has identified the Antelope Valley as a possible site for the proposed Superconducting Super Collider, the world's largest scientific machine; and

WHEREAS, the location of the SSC in the Antelope Valley has the potential to generate \$1 to \$2 million in annual economic spinoffs; will be a magnet for professional and technical talent; will provide employment for 2,500 people with another 500 visiting scientists from around the world working at the site; and

WHEREAS, despite its size, the SSC is expected to be environmentally benign; and

WHEREAS, the location of the SSC in the Antelope Valley will provide the incentive for developing a competitive edge in high tech industries and further enhance Lancaster and the entire Antelope Valley as an important scientific research center to not only the United States but the entire world.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Ridgecrest does hereby support the proposed site of the Superconducting Super Collider in the Antelope Valley.


