

RESOLUTION NO. 87-10

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF RIDGECREST ACCEPTING THE DEED
TO THE PROPERTY KNOWN AS HELLMERS PARK.

WHEREAS, the City of Ridgecrest and Kerr McGee have a long standing agreement for the recreational use of Hellmers Park; and

WHEREAS, this Agreement has proved beneficial to both Kerr McGee and the City whereby the Kerr McGee's need for operational water has been maintained and the City has had a mutually usefull site for recreational purposes; and

WHEREAS, Kerr McGee has determined that their need for the ownership of this property is no longer essential for their operations, and

WHEREAS, Kerr McGee has determined that it would be appropriate and proper to offer this property to the City of Ridgecrest for recreational purposes; and

WHEREAS, the City of Ridgecrest is desirous that this property be deeded to them for ease of administration and future development.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS that the deed to the property known as Hellmers Park be accepted as is attached hereto and herby incorporated by this reference as Exhibit "A", and the same are hereby adopted.


