

RESOLUTION NO. 87-28

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF RIDGECREST AUTHORIZING THE
INSTALLATION OF STOP SIGNS AT RADER AVENUE
AND SUNSET STREET.

WHEREAS, the Streets and Utilities Committee of the City of Ridgecrest has considered a request from residents in the vicinity of Rader Avenue and Sunset Street to install Stop Signs on Rader Avenue at the intersection with Sunset Street; and

WHEREAS, the Streets and Utilities Committee determined that there are sufficient traffic hazards to warrant the installation of Stop Signs at the aforementioned intersection; and

WHEREAS, on the basis of this determination, the Streets and Utilities Committee has recommended to the City Council that Stop Signs be installed on Rader Avenue at Sunset Street.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST RESOLVES as follows:

1. That the installation of Stop Signs on Rader Avenue at Sunset is hereby authorized.
2. That the Director of Public Works is instructed to have said Signs installed as soon as possible.


