

RESOLUTION NO. 87-31

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST AUTHORIZING THE INSTALLATION OF STOP SIGNS AT HOWELL AVENUE AND PEG STREET.

WHEREAS, the Streets and Utilities Committee of the City of Ridgecrest has reviewed the potential traffic hazards at Howell Avenue and Peg Street; and

WHEREAS, Peg Street is a through street and Howell Avenue is a short cul-de-sac on the east side of the intersection, the Streets and Utilities Committee has determined that changing the Stop Signs from Peg Street to Howell Avenue will result in better traffic controls; and

WHEREAS, on the basis of this determination, the Streets and Utilities Committee has recommended to the City Council that the Stop Signs be removed on Peg Street and Stop Signs be installed on Howell Avenue at Peg Street.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST RESOLVES as follows:

1. That the removal of the Stop Signs on Peg Street is hereby authorized.
2. That the installation of Stop Signs on Howell Avenue at Peg Street is hereby authorized.
3. That the Director of Public Works is instructed to have said Signs changed as soon as possible.


