

RESOLUTION NO. 87-38

A RESOLUTION OVERRULING PROTESTS ON
RESOLUTION OF PUBLIC INTEREST OR
NECESSITY AND OF INTENTION NO. 87-18

1987 REFUNDING ASSESSMENT DISTRICT
(ASSESSMENT DISTRICT NO. 14)

RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Ridgecrest,
California, that

WHEREAS, this Council did on February 18, 1987, adopt
its Resolution of Public Interest or Necessity and of
Intention No. 87-18, to refund bonds and levy reassessments
therefore for Assessment District No. 14;

WHEREAS, on March 25, 1987, this Council adopted
Resolution No. 87-27, appointing time and place of hearing
protests in relation to the refunding of bonds and levy of
reassessments and directing notice;

WHEREAS, notice was given of the time and place therein
stated in the manner provided by law, as appears from the
affidavits on file in the office of the Clerk;

WHEREAS, all written protests and other written
communications were publicly read at said meeting and all
persons desiring to be heard were fully heard;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, as follows:

1. That protests against said refunding of bonds and
levy of reassessments were not signed by the owners of a
majority or more of the area of the lands within the
assessment district assessed for the costs and expenses of
said work.

2. That said protests be, and each of them are hereby, overruled.
