

RESOLUTION NO. 87-43

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF RIDGECREST ADOPTING FIVE-YEAR
CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PLAN

The CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Purpose

The City desires to set forth a plan for the construction of capital improvements for the fiscal years 1987-1988 through 1991-1992. This resolution sets forth the capital improvement plan of the City for this period.

Section 2. Five-Year Plan

Attached hereto and hereby incorporated by this reference is the Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan of the City.

Section 3. Limitations

Improvement projects described in the attached Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan are shown in the order in which they are likely to be constructed. In some cases, this order reflects the priority assigned to the project by the City Council. In some cases, however, projects are shown relatively late in the Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan despite very high priority simply because the complexity or scope of the work is such as to make earlier completion impossible.

Section 4. Annual Review

The Council shall annually review its Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan by assessing the progress made in implementing the projects described on the attachment and by adding additional projects for the then existent fifth year.


