

RESOLUTION NO. 87-44

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST REQUESTING THE CORPS OF ENGINEERS TO SECURE FUNDING TO PREPARE A RECONNAISSANCE STUDY FOR THE BOWMAN WASH.

WHEREAS, the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers in November 1985 completed the Initial Appraisal Report for Bowman Wash, City of Ridgecrest, County of Kern, State of California; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Ridgecrest, on February 5, 1986, approved said report and requested that the Corps of Engineers proceed with the Reconnaissance Study as recommended in the Appraisal Report; and

WHEREAS, the City of Ridgecrest is experiencing unprecedented growth, thus making the need for controlling the flooding in Bowman Wash more critical; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Ridgecrest has adopted a Five Year Capital Plan which includes funding for the City's share of cost for the Bowman Flood Control Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST RESOLVES that the Corps of Engineers be requested to take all action necessary to secure funding to perform the Reconnaissance Study of the Bowman Wash at the earliest possible date.


