

RESOLUTION NO. 87-52

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST IN SUPPORT OF AB 2362, GOVERNMENT TORT LIABILITY, AS IT RELATES TO PARKS AND RECREATION FACILITIES.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Ridgecrest desires to continue its Parks and Recreation programs; and

WHEREAS, the City of Ridgecrest, along with Cities throughout the State of California, has been severely impacted with the cost of liability insurance; and
