

RESOLUTION NO. 87-84

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF RIDGECREST DIRECTING PARTIAL
REFUND OF ASSESSMENTS - ASSESSMENT
DISTRICT NO. 14.

WHEREAS, this Council adopted on June 20, 1983, its Resolution of Intention No. 83-41, to acquire and construct improvements within Assessment District No. 14; and

WHEREAS, certain work of improvement was deleted after the assessment was levied and confirmed and after the property owner had paid the assessments in cash; and

WHEREAS, it is appropriate to order the partial refund of the assessed amounts that represent deleted portions of improvements in Assessment District No. 14.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the owner of Diagram and Assessment Number 79 and 80 has requested a partial refund of assessment amounts resulting from deletion of a water extension improvement and a water surcharge, both of which improvements were deleted after the assessment was confirmed and after said owner paid the assessments in cash.

2. The real property subject to this partial refund is as follows:

<u>Diagram & Assessment No.</u>	<u>Amount of Partial Refund</u>
79	\$ 1,364.00
80	\$ 1,014.00

3. That in addition to the aforementioned partial refund, appropriate interest, as determined by the Director of Finance, shall be paid on said partial refund, from the date of payment of the subject assessments in cash to the date of said refund.

4. That the Director of Finance be and he is hereby directed to order the partial refund and draw a warrant on the City's account from such surplus funds as may presently exist for Assessment District No. 14, or, if there are no available funds or said funds had been transferred to the 1987 Refunding Assessment District, then said payment shall be from either the Contingency Fund of said Refunding Assessment District to the extent it is available or from the Reserve Fund.

5. The warrant of the City of Ridgecrest shall be payable to the property owner who paid the assessment in cash upon satisfactory proof to the Finance Director of said payment.
