

RESOLUTION NO. 88-115

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST TO PROHIBIT PARKING ON THE EAST SIDE OF SOUTH CHINA LAKE BOULEVARD FROM A POINT 350 FEET NORTH OF THE CENTERLINE OF RADER AVENUE TO UPJOHN AVENUE.

WHEREAS, the City has received a request by a property owner on the east side of South China Lake Boulevard between Rader Avenue and Upjohn Avenue to prohibit parking on South China Lake Boulevard. This request was made to eliminate a potential traffic hazard.

WHEREAS, the Streets and Utilities Committee and the Public Works Department have reviewed this request and recommend approval.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST DOES HEREBY RESOLVE as follows:

That parking will be prohibited on the east side of South China Lake Boulevard from a point 350 feet north of the centerline of Rader Avenue to Upjohn Avenue and the Director of Public Works is directed to have installed such signs or markings as are necessary to implement this resolution.
