

RESOLUTION NO. 88-173

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST RECITING THE FACT OF THE CONSOLIDATION OF THE STATE-WIDE GENERAL ELECTION HELD ON NOVEMBER 8, 1988, DECLARING THE RESULT AND SUCH OTHER MATTERS AS PROVIDED BY LAW.

WHEREAS, a Consolidated State-Wide Election was held and conducted in the City of Ridgecrest, California, on Tuesday, November 8, 1988, as required by law; and

WHEREAS, notice of the election was given in time, form and manner as provided by law; that voting precincts were properly established; that election officers were appointed and that in all respects the election was held and conducted and the votes were cast, received and canvassed and the returns made and declared in time, form and manner as required by the provisions of the Elections Code of the State of California for the holding of elections in general law cities; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 88-77 adopted June 15, 1988, and Resolution No. 88-80 adopted June 15, 1988, the County Elections Department canvassed the returns of the election and has certified the results to this City Council, the results are received and attached and made a part hereof as "Exhibit A".

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST, CALIFORNIA, DOES RESOLVE, DECLARE, DETERMINE AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1:

That the whole number of ballots cast in the City except absent voter ballots was 9,010.

That the whole number of absent voter ballots cast in the City was 1,099, making a total of 10,109 ballots cast in the City.

Section 2. That the measures voted upon at the election are as follows:

Measure G.

"Shall the City of Ridgecrest be authorized to levy and collect a special tax at the rate of \$40.00 or less, per dwelling unit, per year solely to finance the acquisition, construction, maintenance and operation of City parks?"

Measure H.

"Shall the City of Ridgecrest be authorized to levy and collect a general tax at the rate of 10% of the gross receipts of hotels, motels and other establishments for transient occupancy of persons within the City?

Section 3. That the number of votes given at each precinct and the number of votes given in the City for and against the measures were as listed in Exhibit "A" attached.

Section 4.

The City Council does declare and determine that as a result of the election, a majority of the voters voting on the measure relating to Parks Maintenance did not vote in favor of it, and that the measure was not carried, and shall not be deemed adopted and ratified.

The City Council does declare and determine that as a result of the election, a majority of the voters voting on the measures relating to Transient Occupancy Tax did vote in favor of it, and that the measure was carried, and shall be deemed adopted and ratified.

Section 5. The City Clerk shall enter on the records of the City Council of the City, a statement of the result of the election, showing: (1) The whole number of ballots cast in the City; (2) The measures voted upon; (3) The number of votes given at each precinct for and against each measure; (4) The total number of votes for and against each measure (Exhibit "B").

Section 6. That the City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this resolution and enter it into the book of original resolutions
