

RESOLUTION NO. 88-04

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST DECLARING INTENTION TO ORDER VACATION OF A 60-FOOT-WIDE, 32.51-FOOT-LONG SECTION OF GORDON STREET, LOCATED SOUTH OF DOLPHIN AVENUE BETWEEN DOWNS STREET AND SOUTH CHINA LAKE BOULEVARD.

WHEREAS, it appears that the 332.51' section of Gordon Street south of Dolphin Avenue between Downs Street and China Lake Boulevard is unnecessary for present and or prospective public use; and

WHEREAS, it is desired to hold a public hearing thereon, pursuant to the procedures set forth in Sections 8320 et seq of the Streets and Highways Code of the State of California;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST RESOLVES:

1. That it intends to vacate a 332.51-foot-long section of Gordon Street south of Dolphin Avenue between Downs Street and China Lake Boulevard.

Said street proposed to be abandoned and vacated is shown on a plan on file in the Office of the City Clerk of the City of Ridgecrest, reference to which is made for further particulars.



That a hearing on said proposed vacation will be held at 7:00 p.m. on Wednesday, February 3, 1988 or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard, in the Council Chamber, City Hall, 139 Balsam Street, Ridgecrest, California, at which time all persons interested in or objecting to said proposed vacation may appear and be heard.
3. That this resolution shall be published and posted in the manner prescribed by law.


