NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:


1. That said report is hereby preliminarily approved and ordered filed with the City Clerk, who shall endorse thereon the fact and date of this approval.

That the City Clerk is hereby directed to give notice of the hearing postage prepaid, to each person to whom land in the proposed assessment district is assessed on the last equalized assessment roll of said City, at his address as shown upon such roll, and to each person whether owner in fee or having a lien upon or legal or equity interest in any land within the proposed district, whose name and address and a designation of the lands in which he is interested is on file in the office of the City Clerk.



DESCRIPTION OF WORK

STREET IMPROVEMENT PROJECT NO. 17-E

- (a) The acquisitions and improvements consist generally of the construction of curbs and gutters, sidewalk, excavation, base, paving, and miscellaneous utility improvements on Farragut Street between Vulcan Avenue on the north and Bataan Avenue on the south.
