

RESOLUTION NO. 88-79

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF RIDGECREST ADOPTING RADAR POLICIES
AND PROCEDURES AND AUTHORIZING THE USE OF
RADAR ON LAS FLORES AVENUE AND NORMA
STREET.

WHEREAS, the City Council believes that excessive vehicle speed is a hazard to our community; and

WHEREAS, the City has authorized the limited use of radar to control speed; and

WHEREAS, it is the City Council's desire to afford the driving public with every opportunity to comply with speed limits;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Ridgecrest that Radar Policies and Procedures, attached hereto as Exhibit 1, be adopted and that radar be authorized on Norma Street and Las Flores Avenue.



RADAR

88-79

1. The Police Department is authorized two radar officers. The City Council shall be notified of any change of personnel assigned to radar.
2. The Police Department is required to notify the news media weekly indentifying the streets and days on which radar will be used for speeds less that 55 mph.
3. The Police, Fire and Safety Committee will recommend streets for radar enforcement at speeds less than 55 mph to the City Council. Radar will only be used on streets which have received prior City Council authorization.
4. The Police Department is authorized to use Radar to enforce any speeding violation in excess of 55 mph on City streets within the City.
