A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF RIDGECREST, ADOPTING
CITY COUNCIL POLICY 90-1, REGULATING
ASPHALTIC CONCRETE PAVING FOR COLD
WEATHER.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Ridgecrest wishes to adopt a City policy regarding the requirements for Asphaltic Concrete paving in cold weather; and

WHEREAS, the Streets and Utilities Committee of the City of Ridgecrest has reviewed the subject policy and recommends adoption thereof;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST does hereby adopt City Council Policy 90-1 entitled "Asphaltic Concrete Paving Policy for Cold Weather", as attached in Exhibit "A".



CITY COUNCIL POLICIES

SUBJECT

Asphaltic Concrete
Paving Policy for
Cold Weather

POLICY NO. 90-1

PURPOSE - To establish a policy to allow the paving of streets, which are presently public or are to be accepted for public use in the future, during periods of cold weather.

POLICY - Asphaltic Concrete Paving will be allowed on streets which are public or are intended to be accepted by the City of Ridgecrest for public use only when the following conditions exist:

1. The ambient air temperature is 50 degrees fahrenheit and rising at 8:00 a.m. and,
2. The ground temperature shall not have been below 32 degrees fahrenheit during the previous 72 hours.

In order to prevent base deterioration, paving will be allowed under adverse conditions for the lower one half of the total depth of pavement, with the finish surface paving being completed at a time when the above listed conditions can be met.

All temperatures will be taken by the City Inspector at the jobsite.


