**A Resolution of the City Council of  
the City of Ridgecrest Supporting  
the Establishment of a Superior  
Court Judgeship in the City of  
Ridgecrest.**

WHEREAS, the Indian Wells Valley and the City of Ridgecrest continue to lead the pace for the County in growth; and

WHEREAS, the entire Mojave Desert region of Kern County is growing very rapidly; and

WHEREAS, this growing population is anxious to be served locally by all governmental services; and

WHEREAS, all Mojave Desert residents must now travel up to four hours round trip to avail themselves of a Superior Court; and

WHEREAS, the City of Ridgecrest and the County of Kern have entered into an agreement to design a Superior Court and to operate a full time jail, utilizing redevelopment funds; and

WHEREAS, the judicial arm of the County has agreed that the next Superior Court should be designated in Ridgecrest.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Ridgecrest that our state elected delegation be encouraged to introduce and support legislation authorizing a Superior Court judgeship in the City of Ridgecrest to serve the Mojave Desert Region of Kern County.
