

RESOLUTION NO. 90-33

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST, ESTABLISHING VOTING PRECINCTS AND POLLING PLACES, APPOINTING PRECINCT BOARD MEMBERS AND FIXING COMPENSATION FOR THE GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION ON TUESDAY, APRIL 10, 1990, CALLED BY RESOLUTION NO. 90-01 OF THE CITY COUNCIL.

WHEREAS, a General Municipal Election to be held on Tuesday, April 10, 1990, has been called by Resolution No. 90-01, adopted on January 3, 1990;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST, CALIFORNIA, DOES RESOLVE, DECLARE, DETERMINE AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That for the purpose of holding the General Municipal Election, there is established 10 voting precincts consisting of consolidation of the regular election precincts in the City of Ridgecrest established for the holding of state and county elections, as the regular election precincts exist on the date of adoption of this resolution. That the polling places for the respective precincts shall be the places designated; and that the persons named, being competent and voters and residents of the city are appointed precinct board members for their respective voting precincts and they shall conduct the election in the manner provided by law.
