

RESOLUTION NO. 90-06

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST ORDERING THE SUBMISSION TO THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS OF THE CITY OF A CERTAIN MEASURE RELATING TO ESTABLISHING A POLICE COMMISSION AT THE GENERAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON TUESDAY, APRIL 10, 1990, AS CALLED BY RESOLUTION NO. 90-01.

WHEREAS, a General election on Tuesday, April 10, 1990 has been called by Resolution No. 90-01, adopted on January 3, 1990, and

WHEREAS, the City Council also desires to submit to the voters at the election a question relating to Establishing a Police Commission;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST, CALIFORNIA, DOES RESOLVE, DECLARE, DETERMINE AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the City Council, pursuant to its right and authority, does order submitted to the voters at the General Municipal Election the following questions:

SECTION 2. That the proposed measure submitted to the voters is (as follows: (attached as Exhibit A)

SECTION 3. That in all particulars not recited in this resolution, the election shall be held and conducted as provided by law for holding municipal elections.

SECTION 4. That notice of the time and place of holding the election is given and the City Clerk is authorized, instructed and directed to give further or additional notice of the election, in time, form and manner as required by law.


SECTION 5. That the City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this Resolution and enter it into the book of original Resolutions.
