

RESOLUTION NO. 93-27

**A RESOLUTION OF THE RIDGECREST CITY COUNCIL
ENTERING INTO A COOPERATIVE COMMUNITY
DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT AGREEMENT WITH THE
COUNTY OF KERN**

THE RIDGECREST CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES as follows:

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development has identified this City as authorized to be included in the County of Kern's county Community Development Block Grant Program entitlement pursuant to Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended, (hereinafter the "Act"); and

WHEREAS, HUD has notified County that it is a participant in the HOME Investment Partnership Program as defined in Title II of the Cranston-Gonzales National Affordable Housing Act of 1990, as amended; and

WHEREAS, the Act requires the execution of a Cooperation Agreement between this City and the County of Kern; and

WHEREAS, this agreement allows this City's population to be included with Kern County's to determine a basis grant amount; and

WHEREAS, it is the intention of this City to enter into such an agreement with Kern County to cooperate in undertaking, or assisting in undertaking, essential community development and housing assistance activities, specifically urban renewal and publicly assisted housing in the incorporated areas of this City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Ridgecrest City Council:

1. Elects to participate in the CD Block Grant and HOME Investment Partnership Program for the three program years commencing with 1994-95 and continuing through 1996-97 in accordance with the regulations established by the Act;

2. Directs the City Administrator to sign the required agreements; and

3. Authorizes the City Administrator from this City to execute and/or perform all other appropriate acts necessary to accomplish the purpose of the resolution.
