

**RESOLUTION NO. 93-56**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF  
THE CITY OF RIDGECREST ESTABLISHING  
A SOLID WASTE AD HOC ADVISORY  
COMMITTEE**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council has adopted a Source Reduction and Recycling Element on April 7 of 1992; and

**WHEREAS**, that document called for the establishment of a solid waste committee:

**WHEREAS**, the Council has advertised for interested and qualified citizens to sit on such a committee;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that: the City Council of the City of Ridgecrest:

1. Hereby forms a five member Citizens Ad Hoc Solid Waste Committee pursuant to the Source Reduction and Recycling Element; and
2. Declares that the committee's duties shall be generally to formulate, review, and identify alternatives for the implementation of the Source Reduction and Recycling Element and prepare recommendations for the City Council, Council Committees and Planning Commission; and
3. Defines the Committee to consist of 5 members (who are citizens of Ridgecrest) with each City Council member to present a nominee for appointment by the Council as a whole; and
4. The Committee shall convene at an early opportunity and commence the work required by the Source Reduction and Recycling Element and the City Council; and
5. The Citizens Ad Hoc Solid Waste Committee shall receive no compensation but shall receive reimbursement for expenses incurred while on City business, provided, such expenses are authorized by the Council; and

6. The Community Development and Public Works Departments shall assist the Committee in performance of its duties.
