

RESOLUTION NO. 93-68

**A RESOLUTION OF THE RIDGECREST CITY COUNCIL
APPOINTING THE HANDICAPPED ACCESS APPEALS
BOARD TO ACT AS THE AMERICANS WITH
DISABILITIES ACT (A.D.A.) ADVISORY BOARD AND TO
REQUIRE THE BOARD TO COMPLY WITH CERTAIN
A.D.A. REGULATIONS**

WHEREAS, the Americans With Disabilities Act was signed into law July 26, 1990 by President Bush, and

WHEREAS, Title I and Title II of the Americans With Disabilities Act require all public entities to perform a self-evaluation of current employment practices and the provision of public service, thereby identifying potential sources of discrimination against disabled persons, and

WHEREAS, Americans With Disabilities Act regulations require the involvement of disabled persons and/or representative organizations in the self-evaluation process, and

WHEREAS, Two persons with disabilities currently sit on the Handicapped Access Appeals Board.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Ridgecrest that the Handicapped Access Appeals Board shall serve as the Americans With Disabilities Act Advisory Board, and that the Americans With Disabilities Act Advisory Board shall be charged with the responsibility of performing the ADA self-evaluation for the City of Ridgecrest
