A RESOLUTION OF THE RIDGECREST CITY COUNCIL
PROVIDING FOR APPLICATION AND ACCEPTANCE OF
URBAN MASS TRANSPORTATION ACT (UMTA)
SECTION 18 TRANSIT ASSISTANCE GRANTS

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE RIDGECREST CITY COUNCIL as follows:

WHEREAS, The Department of Transportation of the State of California evaluates and approves applications for federal transit assistance under Section 18 of the Urban Mass Transportation Act (UMTA) of 1964, as amended; and

WHEREAS, The City of Ridgecrest desires to enter into such agreements with the State of California;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Ridgecrest City Council further resolves as follows:

Section 1. The City desires to request federal grant funding to provide assistance for the Ridgecrest Area Transit System (RATS).

Section 2. The City Administrator is authorized to execute applications, agreements and appropriate claims pursuant to any said agreements.
