

RESOLUTION 94-04

A RESOLUTION OF THE RIDGECREST CITY COUNCIL CERTIFYING THE NEGATIVE ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION FOR ORDINANCE AMENDMENT AS IT RELATES TO LOT WIDTH REQUIREMENTS IN CERTAIN AREAS;

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST RESOLVES as follows:

SECTION 1: FINDINGS:

On February 16, 1994 the City Council held a public hearing and duly and regularly considered the environmental impact for ordinance amendment as it relates to lot width requirements in certain areas; City of Ridgecrest, applicant.

The City Council considered the initial study and evaluation and recommends approval of the certification and filing of a Negative Declaration based upon the findings that:

- (a) The project is in compliance with zoning regulations and procedures.
- (b) The project is in conformity with the applicable elements of the General Plan and specific plans.
- (c) The design of the project will not cause substantial environmental damage or injure fish or wildlife or their habitats.

SECTION 2. ENVIRONMENTAL CERTIFICATION

The City Council hereby adopts and certifies a Negative Declaration for the project subject to no (0) mitigation measure:

The City Council authorizes and instructs the City Clerk of the City of Ridgecrest to file a Notice of Determination as required by law.


