

RESOLUTION NO. 94-52

**A RESOLUTION OF THE RIDGECREST CITY COUNCIL
REGARDING THE KERN COUNTY AIR POLLUTION
CONTROL DISTRICT AIR POLLUTION CONTROL
BOARD COMPOSITION**

WHEREAS, the California League of Cities sponsored legislation amending the California Health and Safety Code, Assembly Bill 75 (Hauser), which was signed into law as Chapter 961 on October 11, 1993; and

WHEREAS, the amendments require that the governing board of the Kern County Air Pollution Control District consist of at least one city mayor or city council member, and at least one county supervisor; and

WHEREAS, the numbers and composition of the Air Pollution Control Board shall be determined jointly by the county and cities within the district, and shall be approved by the county, and by a majority of the cities which contain a majority of the population in the incorporated area of the district; and

WHEREAS, the city representatives on the Air Pollution Control Board shall reflect, to the extent feasible and practicable, the geographic diversity of the district and the variation of population between the cities in the district;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Ridgecrest hereby approves a composition of the Kern County Air Pollution Control Board consisting of two (2) city mayors and/or council members, which shall include the mayor or a council member from the City of Ridgecrest and the mayor or a council member from either California City or Tehachapi, and three (3) county supervisors.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the county employees currently acting as staff to the Kern County Air Pollution Control District shall continue to act as ex officio officers and employees of the District as provided in Health and Safety Code Section 40120.


