**A RESOLUTION OF THE RIDGECREST CITY COUNCIL  
APPROVING THE TIME EXTENSION OF THE  
MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE  
CITY OF RIDGECREST AND THE BUREAU OF LAND  
MANAGEMENT FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE  
WESTER MOHAVE COORDINATED HABITAT  
MANAGEMENT PLAN**

**WHEREAS**, the Bureau of Land Management has been developing a plan to meet the requirements of the U.S. Fish and Wildlife service and the California Department of Fish and Game as it pertains to the endangered and threatened species of the Western Mojave Desert;

**WHEREAS**, this plan will meet the requirements of the Federal Endangered Species Act and the California Endangered Species Act;

**WHEREAS**, the primary goal of this plan is to create a system of uniform mitigations for loss of habitat that will apply to all jurisdictions within the planning area;

**WHEREAS**, this plan has the potential of providing for biodiversity of species and eliminate the need for further listing of a species as endangered;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the Ridgecrest City Council hereby approves a time extension for the Memorandum of Understanding between the Bureau of Land Management and the City of Ridgecrest and authorizes the Mayor to execute said agreement.
