

RESOLUTION NO. 94-67

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, TO SIGN THE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN NAWS, CHINA LAKE AND THE CITY OF RIDGECREST AGREEING TO PROVIDE CERTAIN SERVICES TO MEET THE GRANT APPLICATION MADE TO KCAPCD THAT WILL ULTIMATELY BENEFIT VIEWEG SCHOOL.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Ridgecrest and NAWS, China Lake jointly agreed to support a grant application to the Kern County Air Pollution Control District for the construction of Chelsea Street;

WHEREAS, the purpose of this joint application was to reduce vehicle emissions through the reduction of trip length, and to create an access from the City directly to Vieweg School; and

WHEREAS, the City and NAWS, China Lake have both agreed to provide certain in lieu service to provide for the completion of the Chelsea Street extension;

WHEREAS, the with the construction of the Chelsea Street extension, Vieweg School will afforded access from City maintained streets and the Sierra Sands School District will be afforded greater ease in accomplishing its future redistricting plans.

NOW THEREFORE THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST authorizes the Mayor to sign the Memorandum of understanding on behalf of the City.
