A RESOLUTION OF THE RIDGECREST CITY COUNCIL
AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SIGN THE MEMORANDUM
OF UNDERSTANDING WITH KERN COUNTY FOR THE
1994-1995 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT
ENTITLEMENT MONIES TO BE USED IN THE
CONSTRUCTION OF THE BALSAM STREET PEDESTRIAN
MALL

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Ridgecrest elected to participate in the Kern County managed Community Development Block Grant program; and

WHEREAS, the City Council did authorize staff to make application to Kern County for the use of these monies to construct the Balsam Street Pedestrian Mall; and

WHEREAS, staff has been proceeding to complete the justification requirements for the Department of Housing and Urban Development for this project; and

WHEREAS, the Kern County Board of Supervisors did approve the City of Ridgecrest application to construct the Balsam Street Pedestrian Mall under the Community Development Block Grant Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST authorizes the Mayor to sign the Memorandum of understanding on behalf of the City.




