**A RESOLUTION OF THE RIDGECREST CITY COUNCIL
APPROVING THE PROJECT LIST FOR THE 1994-95
COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT FUNDING**

WHEREAS, the City of Ridgecrest has elected to participate in the Community Development Block Grant Program as administered by Kern County; and

WHEREAS, the Community Development Block Grant program's primary objective as established by Congress is to assist in the development of viable urban communities; and

WHEREAS, the projects proposed by the City of Ridgecrest will meet the criteria established by Congress of:

- (a) an activity that will alleviate existing conditions which pose a serious and immediate threat to the health and welfare of the community and must have developed or become critical within the past 19 months;
- (b) aid in the prevention or elimination of slums or blight; and/or
- (c) principally benefit persons of low or moderate income;

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Ridgecrest has held a duly notice public hearing to take comments in public hearing on the proposed projects and those suggested by the public.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE RIDGECREST CITY COUNCIL HEREBY approves staff making application to the Community Development Block Grant Program for the proposed projects as set forth in "Exhibit A" attached to this resolution.



EXHIBIT 'A'

PROJECTS PROPOSED FOR APPLICATION IN ORDER OF PRIORITY

- A. **Balsam Street:** reconstruct the infrastructure of Balsam Street for the length between Ridgecrest Boulevard and Argus Avenue as conceptualized in the "Downtown Revitalization Plan" as prepared by Barrio Planners.
- B. **Sunset/Allen Streets:** construct curb, gutter, and street paveouts for the east side of Sunset Street and both sides of Allen Street for the lengths located between Upjohn Avenue and Bowman Road.

Culvert at Church and China Lake Intersection: construct required drainage improvements at this intersection in anticipation of the 1995 paving program for China Lake Boulevard that will be funded by Transit Enhancement Activities (TEA) funding.
- C. **Norma Street:** construct curb, gutter and street paving on the west side of Norma for the length located between Upjohn and Bowman Road.

Church Avenue ADA Project: construct 33 curb returns that comply with the requirements of the ADA.
