**A RESOLUTION OF THE RIDGECREST CITY COUNCIL
REJECTING THE PROPOSALS RECEIVED FOR BODY
ARMOR**

WHEREAS, the department has budgeted funds to replace body armor in the FY 1995/96 budget and,

WHEREAS, the City and P.E.A.R., the recognized labor group, have entered into past memorandum of understanding that the City shall supply body armor to all sworn personnel, and

WHEREAS, the department has solicited and received "Request for Proposals" to provide body armor according to the specifications and standards as published in the National Law Enforcement Technology Center, Nation Institute of Justice STD 101.01 Voluntary Standard; N.I.J. Standard 0101.03. Certified Level III-A; PPAA STD-1989-05 Certified.

NOW THEREFORE, The City Council does hereby reject all proposals received for body armor due to proposals being either over budget or not meeting specifications.
