**A RESOLUTION OF THE RIDGECREST CITY COUNCIL
APPROVING A REWARD PROGRAM FOR THE POLICE
DEPARTMENT AND AUTHORIZING UP TO \$1,000 BE
PLACED INTO THE ACCOUNT FROM THE POLICE
DEPARTMENT BUDGET**

WHEREAS, the department desires to establish a reward program and wants to offer up to \$3,000;

NOW THEREFORE, the Ridgecrest City Council does hereby approve the "Reward Program" account and authorizes an expenditure of up to \$1,000 from the Police Department budget in addition to the donations.


