

RESOLUTION NO. 96-60

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL DIRECTING THE CHIEF OF POLICE AND THE CITY ATTORNEY TO INVESTIGATE THE INCORPORATION OF P.A.C.T. AND DEVELOP ANY NECESSARY AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, the volunteer organization known as P.A.C.T., working for the Ridgecrest Police Department has proven to be an invaluable resource, providing thousands of hours of dedicated volunteer service; and

WHEREAS, the organization desired to incorporate for the purpose of being eligible for certain non-profit grants and donations; and

WHEREAS, P.A.C.T. did subsequently form such a corporation, not realizing that it could inadvertently remove itself from under the umbrella of the City of Ridgecrest and its direct affiliation with the police department, and that Council approval could be necessary for such a corporation; and

WHEREAS, it is extremely beneficial to the City of Ridgecrest, the Ridgecrest Police Department, the citizens of Ridgecrest, and the P.A.C.T. Organization, itself, that this organization's current status not inadvertently be changed; and

NOW, THEREFORE, the Chief of Police and the City Attorney are directed to investigate the impact of such incorporation, and to develop any necessary agreement between the City and the Organization. These necessary agreements will minimally include, Articles of Incorporation, By-laws, and Memorandum of Understanding.

It is further directed that the results of these efforts be brought back to the Council for review and approval.


