

RESOLUTION NO. 96-75

**A RESOLUTION OF THE RIDGECREST CITY COUNCIL  
AMENDING THE RIDGECREST POLICE DEPARTMENT  
BUDGET TO INCORPORATE THE FUNDING AS  
APPROPRIATED BY ASSEMBLY BILL 2788 (PROP 172),  
GOVERNMENT CODE SECTION 30051-30056, PUBLIC SAFETY  
AUGMENTATION FUND (P.S.A.F.)**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Ridgecrest has qualified for funds under Assembly Bill 2788, also known as Proposition 172, and Codified under Government Code Section 30051-30056, known as Public Safety Augmentation Fund (P.S.A.F.), which is a distribution of a partial rebate of the 1/2 per cent sales tax established by Senate Constitutional Amendment in 1993; and,

**WHEREAS**, this money is to supplement and not supplant existing law enforcement budget.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, be it resolved that the City Council of the City of Ridgecrest direct the Finance Director to establish the appropriate revenue and expense accounts to track these funds.


