

RESOLUTION NO. 96-82

**A RESOLUTION OF THE RIDGECREST CITY COUNCIL  
RESCINDING RESOLUTION NO. 92-41 AS IT RELATES  
TO THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A SPAY AND NEUTER  
PROGRAM WITH THE INDIAN WELLS VALLEY HUMANE  
SOCIETY**

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE RIDGECREST CITY COUNCIL** as follows:

**Section 1. Purpose**

A spay and neuter program and the collection of deposits to support such a program is required by law. Historically, the Ridgecrest Animal Shelter had accumulated an excess of surplus deposits. The IWV Humane Society had presented a program, wherein the City of Ridgecrest had agreed to transfer surplus funds to them by Resolution 92-41. Since 1992, the city of Ridgecrest has channeled approximately \$100,000 through the IWV Humane Society for the purpose of funding a spay/neuter program. Excess deposits have been depleted and the implementation of sound management practices will eliminate the accumulation of excess funds. Though the IWV Humane Society made excellent use of those funds while they were available, the need to channel excess funds through them no longer exists.

**Section 2. Authorization**

The City Council hereby rescinds Resolution No. 92-41, and terminates the current policy of transferring funds from the Ridgecrest Animal Control spay/neuter fund to the IWV Humane Society.




