

RESOLUTION 98-104

A RESOLUTION OF THE RIDGECREST CITY COUNCIL SETTING A PUBLIC HEARING DATE TO TAKE COMMENTS ON DECLARATION OF INTENTION TO ORDER VACATION OF A PORTION OF THE FLORENCE STREET RIGHT OF WAY WITH RESERVATION OF AN EASEMENT FOR PUBLIC UTILITIES AND SERVICE

WHEREAS, it appears that the public right of way known as The north 587.96 feet of Florence Street north of Las Flores Avenue, as described in Exhibit A, with the reservation of a public utility and service easement along this same alignment is unnecessary for present and or prospective public use: and

WHEREAS, it is desired to hold a Public Hearing thereon, pursuant to the procedures set forth in Sections 8320, et seq of the Streets and Highways Code of the State of California;

NOW, THEREFORE THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST RESOLVES:

1. That it intends to abandon and vacate the public rights of way known as The north 587.96 feet of Florence Street north of Los Flores Avenue, as described in Exhibit A, with the reservation of a public utility and service easement.

Said public rights of way proposed to be abandoned and vacated is shown on a plan on file in the office of the City Clerk of the City of Ridgecrest, reference to which is made for further particulars.

2. That a hearing on said proposed abandonment and vacation will be held at 7:00 P.M. on Wednesday, December 16, 1998, or as soon as possible thereafter, in the Council Chambers, City Hall, 100 W. California Avenue, Ridgecrest, California, at which time all persons interested in or objecting to said proposed abandonment and vacation may appear and be heard.
3. That this resolution shall be published and posted in the manner prescribed by law.


