

RESOLUTION NO. 98 -105

**A RESOLUTION OF THE RIDGECREST CITY COUNCIL
SETTING THE PUBLIC HEARING TO CONSIDER
COMMENTS AND RECOMMENDATIONS FOR "UNMET
NEEDS" IN THE PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION SYSTEM**

WHEREAS, during each year the City of Ridgecrest receives rural federal transit assistance under several sources of funding; Transportation Development Act Funds (TDA), Federal Transit Administration funds (FTA), and passenger fare revenues. Additionally, the City of Ridgecrest receives capital grant assistance funds Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality (CMAQ) Program.

NOW THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Ridgecrest does hereby resolve as follows:

Section 1. The Public Hearing to hear comments and recommendations for "unmet needs" in public transportation in the City of Ridgecrest and surrounding areas covered under a Joint Powers Agreement (JPA) with the County of Kern is hereby set for Wednesday, December 16, 1998 at 7:00 p.m., or as soon as possible thereafter, in the City Council Chambers.




