**A RESOLUTION OF THE RIDGECREST CITY
COUNCIL AWARDING BID TO PACIFIC DESIGN
CONCEPT TO RETROFIT PLAYGROUND
EQUIPMENT AT PEARSON PARK**

**NOW THEREFORE, THE RIDGECREST CITY COUNCIL DOES HEREBY RESOLVE
as follows:**

- Section 1. In accordance with the American Disabilities Act, as required by the State of California and the Federal Government, City Council approved \$25,000 from the Park Development Fund in the FY 98-99 Budget, page 9, for Playground Equipment Improvements at City Parks.
- Section 2. The sole-source bid form Pacific Design Concepts in the amount of \$15,941.14 includes new equipment; freight; tax; demolition of existing equipment and installation of new equipment.
- Section 3. The work is required to correct the current condition of the area and to meet ADA requirements.
- Section 4. The Ridgecrest City Council approves the award to Pacific Design Concepts, in the amount of \$15,941.14.
